

NHCH Co-op Classes

NHCH will offer supplemental classes on Monday from 9:00 am - 2:00 pm during the school year at New Hope Baptist Church. These classes are offered as a service to our member families and are optional, but if you choose to participate we expect you to be on time, follow all rules outlined in the NHCH handbook, and be consistent in your attendance. All property at New Hope Baptist Church must be treated with respect. Damages incurred by a student/parent will be the responsibility of the parent. New Hope Baptist Church and NHCH are not responsible for any accidents or injuries occurring on the property of New Hope Baptist Church or traveling to and from New Hope Baptist Church or any NHCH functions. The teachers are NHCH members or community members with expertise or experience in a particular area and have a desire to teach. None of these classes are required, but once a student is enrolled, he/she is expected to complete the requirements as outlined by the teacher. Each family that attends co-op is required to have a parent or responsible adult on campus for the duration of the day's activities. Each adult is expected to actively participate by helping with classes, watching the halls, etc. If you don't have an assigned task, please check with a NHCH Admin to see if there is an opportunity for you to serve. The success of our co-op depends on the willingness of our parents to volunteer and serve.

Please remember that classes are open to all homeschoolers, A church-school agreement form (liability waiver) will be required from each family participating in coop.

There are no additional fees to participate in coop, although some of the classes may require you to purchase supplies or pay a small yearly fee for supplies or require a book. Please consider these when you sign up for classes.

We will have an art fair, history fair, and science fair this year. All fairs will take place concurrently with classes during regular coop times. All classes will continue as scheduled.

Field trips will not take place during coop times. Field trips will be scheduled throughout the year and dates and times will be posted when information is available. If there is a field trip you would like to do, please speak with an admin.

Co-op Class Information

Classes will be on Mondays from 9:00 am- 2:00 pm. We will have a total of 28 co-op classes, 14 in the fall and 14 in the spring. We will have a snack break at 11:30 and lunch break at 12:30. No snacks/ lunch will be provided by NHCH.

All grades

We will have a group Bible lesson covering basics in Bible as well as character development.

Pre-K

All Hours- Pre K- \$5

Open to siblings of students enrolled with NHCH or child of a parent who is teaching. We will be using a Letter of the Week curriculum and through children's story to go with the letter of the day. We will be incorporating crafts and other activities. Hands on activities will be used to learn shapes, numbers, colors and letters as well as to encourage sharing and being thoughtful of one another.

Kindergarten- 2nd Grade

1st Hour- Magic School Bus Science- \$5

We will be working through "The Magic School Bus" television series. We will learn about physical science, earth science, biology and more. Each class we will complete a worksheet, activity, or project on the subject of the day.

2nd Hour- History- \$5

1st Semester we will focus on the Little House Series doing activities and crafts based on the books. 2nd Semester we will watch a short Liberty Kids episode and learn about the Revolutionary War. We will also do a craft or worksheet with each video.

3rd Hour- Art- \$5

4th Hour- Clubs

Lego Club- 1st & 3rd Monday of the month. We will work team building as well as individual projects.

Book Club- 2nd & 4th Monday of the month. We will read grade-level appropriate books. We will discuss the books we read during our meeting. We will also do activities based on the book.
