

Nursery-

This class is for teachers and co-teachers who have a baby/young toddler that needs someone to watch them while they are teaching in a class. You will need to let us know what hours you will need this class. You will still need to register for this class.

Pre K

All 3 hours- \$20

Students will have fun games and activities each week as they learn the alphabet, counting, writing, colors, shapes and silly songs and games. Students will need a folder to keep their work in. PreK is for ages 4-5 and is open to children of teachers and siblings of older students.

K-2

1st hour- Bible \$5

Students will learn about the Bible through group readings, worksheets, art activities, Bible quizzes, and hands on projects. Students will need a folder and pencil each week.

2nd hour- Wild Kratts \$10

This class is based on the favorite PBS tv show. Each week students will learn about a different animal or habitat. They will watch an episode of Wild Kratts and do activities or crafts to go along with the show. Students will need a folder and pencil each week.

3rd hour- Read to Me Dr. Seuss- \$10

We will read and explore Dr. Seuss books. We will have crafts and activities to go along with the books. Students will need a folder and pencil each week.

3-5 grade

1st Hour- Liberty Kids History \$10

Students will learn about the American Revolution and events surrounding it using the Liberty Kids series. Students will need a folder and pencil each week.

2nd hour- Bible \$5

Students will learn about the Bible through group readings, worksheets, art activities, Bible quizzes, and hands on projects. Students will need a folder and pencil each week.

3rd hour- Game Zone \$10

Students will learn history, grammar, science and geography through board games and fun activities.

3rd hour (2nd Monday of each month only)- 4H \$0

Students will meet the 2nd Monday of each month to learn a new skill or to work on projects using 4H curriculum. Our 4H agent will be in to lead the meetings and provide information on upcoming events and monthly project entries. Students will need a folder and pencil. If your child is elected as an officer, student may have additional responsibilities including writing news reports, taking photos and submitting them to the admins, and leading the meetings. Officers must be at each 4h meeting. Please discuss this with your child before the child takes an officer position.

6-8 grade

1st hour- Health & Anatomy \$5

Students will use Kids Health videos, scripture and crafts to learn about how the body works. (We will NOT be discussing puberty as that is best taught by each parent.)

2nd hour- 4H \$0

Students will meet each week to learn a new skill or to work on projects using 4H curriculum. Our 4H agent will be in once a month to lead the meetings (2nd Monday) and provide information on upcoming events and monthly project entries. Students will need a folder and pencil. If your child is elected as an officer, student may have additional responsibilities including writing news reports, taking photos and submitting them to the admins/ agent, and leading the meetings. 3rd hour- Robotics \$30

9-12 grade

1st hour- Around the World Geography \$20

Students will learn basics of geography, landmarks and other cultures through art and other activities as we study the continents. Students will need a binder with copy paper and notebook paper, pencil, colored pencils each week.

2nd hour- 4H \$0

Students will meet each week to learn a new skill or to work on projects using 4H curriculum. Our 4H agent will be in once a month to lead the meetings (2nd Monday) and provide information on upcoming events and monthly project entries. Students will need a folder and pencil. If your child is elected as an officer, student may have additional responsibilities including writing news reports, taking photos and submitting them to the admins/ agent, and leading the meetings. 2nd hour- Chemistry 101 \$20
